A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

Dear PHS parents and families:

We are busy at school putting the final touches on what I anticipate will be a GREAT year. The teachers and staff are back at work, and we are so excited to get to see our students very soon.

I need to bring your attention to the circumstances regarding our **master schedule**. As you have probably seen on the national news, there is an ongoing teacher shortage across the country. Providence is not immune to this circumstance. We have hired excellent teachers at Providence (the best anywhere). But, we still have a few vacancies. In some cases, there have been no applicants for the vacant position. That has created a situation where we have very, very full classes and little to no room to allow students to change their schedule. We have filled classes to the extent that student/staff safety would allow.

PowerSchool will open on Monday morning for students to see their schedules. Because of large class sizes and limits to the courses we can offer due to teacher vacancies, requests for schedule changes will ONLY be considered <u>if absolutely necessary</u> as defined by the following:

- 1. Students needs a course added to meet graduation requirements.
- 2. Student is enrolled in a course they have already completed and received credit.
- 3. Student is enrolled in a course for which they have not met the prerequisite.
- 4. Student does not have a full schedule.

- 5. Student wants to move up to a higher level course (space permitting).
- 6. Student did not receive a course they were approved for via audition/interview (schedule constraints and space permitting).
- 7. Seniors who want to drop a 4th block course for early release (with proper paperwork and approval). We will not be able to rearrange the courses to create a space for early release.

Upon review of your child's schedule (both first and second semesters), if you need to request a schedule change for one of the above reasons only, you may complete a schedule change request form available in the main office or on our website beginning Monday. <u>Only one schedule change request</u> form may be submitted per student, so please consider your requests carefully.

Our counselors will be in CMS required trainings next week. They will not be on campus to meet with parents or students. They will be handling schedule change request forms at night and after hours. Schedule change requests will be handled in the order in which they are received, so please submit the form either to our main office, or by fax to (980) 343-3957.

Back-to-School Letter

You should have received our back-to-school letter via U.S. mail. It contains some important information, including bus details, homeroom teacher name and room number, and a map of our drive through should you be bringing or picking up your child from Providence. Please review this information and make sure your child reviews it so we can have a smooth start to the school year.

Rising 9th Grade Orientation

Rising 9th graders are reminded of orientation on **Friday, August 25 from 3-5 PM**. We will have an information session in the auditorium, and then students will have an opportunity to walk their schedule and find their classrooms. To accommodate all rising 9th graders, we will stagger the orientation session in the auditorium. **We can accommodate the student and parents only**.

The information session will help prepare students (and parents) for the first days of high school. Most 9th grade teachers will be in their rooms from **3-5 PM** (health/PE teachers will be in the gym lobby) to meet you. Due to sporting events and practice, some teachers will not be available but students can find their classrooms and learn to navigate the building. Before **3 PM**, teachers will be in a required workshop and unavailable, so please do not arrive before **3 PM**.

Bus Transportation

The link below will provide bus information. It will let you know if your student has been assigned a bus. (You will need your student's school ID number.)

Any bus requests made after August 1 are not guaranteed transportation the first week of school. Please make other transportation arrangements until you know a bus has been assigned.

Please call the CMS transportation department at (98) 343-5715 if you have any questions about transportation. Students should plan to arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes prior to the time listed.

Students and parents are invited to sign up for the "Here Comes the Bus" app. Directions are on the CMS website at <u>Transportation Services/Here Comes the Bus App</u> (cmsk12.org). This app will tell you where your bus is.

Student Parking on Campus

Starting the first day, **August 28**, students who park at Providence must have a valid parking permit displayed on their vehicle window. Parked cars without valid parking permits will be ticketed and/or booted and fined \$25.

With regard to student parking:

1) On **Monday, August 21 and Tuesday, August 22, 8 AM–10 AM** both mornings, we will sell parking permits for the remaining spaces in our student parking lot.

To be eligible, students must be a junior or senior and have a **cumulative weighted GPA of 2.0 or higher.** Students can verify their cumulative GPA in Naviance. Students will need to log into their NCEdCloud account. From there, click on the Clever icon, then you will see the blue Naviance app. Students who will be out of town at these times, and who otherwise qualify to purchase a parking permit, can send their completed forms by a parent or friend who can select the space for them. Juniors and seniors who do not yet have their driver's license will have a later opportunity to purchase a parking permit, space permitting. Right now, we are only selling permits to students who qualify and have their license.

Parking permits cannot be purchased if the student owes a fee to the school. Students and parents can check Online School Payments (link on the left-hand side on the home page of our website) and pay any fees online so they will be eligible to purchase a permit.

The following items are required:

- 1. Please print and read the <u>STUDENT PARKING AUTHORIZATION form</u> at this link (front and back). There are places for the student and parent to sign and initial on both pages.
- Students are to bring a copy of their driver's license and valid vehicle registration card. Students cannot make copies on campus, so please make copies in advance. You will leave the copies with us.
- 3. A \$25 parking permit fee, which should be paid by credit card on Online School Payments (OSP) prior to **August 21 or 22**.
- 2) If a student purchased their parking sticker on **August 10 or 11** and did not have their vehicle with them to have their decal affixed to the windshield, please bring the vehicle to school on

Monday, August 21 or Tuesday, August 22 between 8 AM and 10 AM 8am. Students will not be permitted to park on campus until they receive their official parking sticker/decal. After 10 AM on August 22, the next available time to bring the vehicle to receive the decal will be after school starts.

Police will increase patrols in the area around our school to ensure the safety of students who walk to school and those who drive. <u>Also, please note that the neighborhoods and apartment complexes near</u> <u>Providence have indicated they will begin towing illegally parked cars on the first day of school.</u>

School Communication

We have begun to use ParentSquare to communicate with parents /families/students. CMS purchased its own CMS ParentSquare app for our families (although the app is not required to receive messages). This week, you may have received messages via regular email (our listserv) as well as on ParentSquare. ParentSquare seems to have received email addresses from PowerSchool, so that is how many of our students and parents are already receiving messages. Next week, I will send out information about how to join ParentSquare should you need it.

We have our opening football game tonight at **7 PM** against Ardrey Kell High School. I expect it to be a good game! We will have a fully operational concession stand, so come hungry and come out to support our team, band, and cheerleaders. Go Panthers!

Player Registration

This year CMS has changed its process for athlete registration. The Dragonfly site will be used to collect all documents, including physicals, proof of residency, and other required documents. This site will also be where the required CMS athletic participation fee will be collected. All this information must be completed prior to first games, but many coaches may require this information to be completed shortly after tryouts. The registration site is <u>dragonflyathletics.com</u>. Please start this process now so there is no delay in students' participation in PHS sports.

Providence Athletic Fee

The Providence athletic fee, which is paid by student athletes, is the primary fundraiser for Providence Athletics and supports all PHS sports.
