A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

Dear PHS parents and families:

Today, I was talking to a group of students who said this short week seems like it has been a long one. I know what they mean. Somehow, we have managed to fit what feels like 6 days of work into 4 school days! As we look ahead to the month of March, that trend might continue. There is no room left on the school calendar. Students will be very busy with their school work but have also made time to plan some school-wide events with their clubs, organize the Student Hunger Drive, put the finishing touches on the Spring Musical, and pack the schedule with many athletic events. We'll guide you through the events week by week. Here are some upcoming highlights:

1) Our 11th graders will take the ACT on March 8. This test is required, is being paid for by the State of NC, and scores are reportable to colleges. On Monday, 11th graders will bring home a booklet with reminder information. I'll also email 11th grade parents some reminders. Our core 11th grade teachers are working hard to prepare students for the test. At this point, it is not so much about teaching content, but is about teaching them specific test strategies to conquer the ACT. Year

after year Providence has the highest ACT test scores in CMS (and tops in NC) so encouraging your child to listen, learn, and apply the strategies we are teaching them can pay off.

- 2) March 8 is an Early Release day for all students (for teacher professional development). 9th, 10th, and 12th graders will have all 4 classes with dismissal at **11:15 AM**. 11th graders will take the ACT with dismissal at **11:15 AM**. We will start promptly at **7:15 AM** so students should be at school a few minutes early.
- 3) Our Student Government/Leadership has planned a great Versus week **March 13–17**. Please see the information in the section below for a brief update.
- 4) Senior Exit presentations will be on **March 16** for seniors in English IV this semester.
- 5) Midterm exams for 4x4 classes will be **March 21–24** during the regular school day, during regular classes. We will communicate more information to students in school about which exam will be on which day.
- 6) The Spring Musical opens on March 24 and will show for 6 days over 2 weekends.

In addition, we are beginning the Course Request process for our rising 9th graders. We are visiting each of our feeder middle schools this month. We will host Panthers on the Prowl, our rising 9th grade orientation, on **March 30** at Providence HS.

We are excited about the many happenings at Providence. Thank you for sending your child to work with us. We love having them at school. I hope you have a great weekend.
