DATES TO REMEMBER

A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

Dear PHS Parents and Families:

Second semester classes began yesterday and all indications are that we are off to a good start. With new courses, students' lunch times may have changed. They have quickly adjusted. We have encouraged our students to make a good impression on their new teachers and start strong. Starting strong now can help lead to good results at the end of the year. For those students who are in A/B day classes, even though half the year is over, only 40% of the overall course grade has been earned. There is 60% of the grade still to be earned (40% for 2nd semester and 20% for the Final exam). Students still have plenty of time to make sure they are where they want to be with regard to their academics by June.

Today, I shared with students some recent data that was released by NC Department of Public Instruction (this information was also shared in the PawPrints)

Providence has:

- The <u>highest</u> Advanced Placement exam (AP) pass rate of any comprehensive HS in CMS (84.5%)
- The <u>highest</u> average SAT score of any comprehensive HS in CMS (average score of 1244)
- The <u>highest</u> ACT average in CMS (average score of 24.5).

I encouraged students to continue to listen to their teachers and learn from them. The combination of <u>eager students willing to listen and learn</u> with <u>highly experienced and qualified teachers</u> who know the recipe for academic success is what creates these excellent results year after year.

Also, yesterday, we launched the **Course Request Process for the 2023-24 school year**. Here is a copy of the <u>parent letter</u> that was sent home. Each student also received their Course Request Card. Students have until **February 8** to consult with their parents, consult with their current teachers, etc. and complete their card. We require the student to consult with the parent and get their signature on the card. We will collect all cards on February 8. Then, counselors will meet with each student to review their selections and talk about their future plans. Students can change their mind anytime up until **April 4 which is Last Chance Day**. That gives students (and parents) a solid two months to consult, consider, and think about their course requests so informed decisions can be made.

We will host three events on **Tuesday night (January 31)** to help students / parents with course decisions:

- AP Capstone Information session, 5:00pm- 5:30pm, Auditorium: This information session is for current honors level 9th graders and their parents who might be interested in earning an AP Capstone diploma. Acceptance into the AP Capstone program is by application. Students will take 2 AP Courses (AP Seminar and AP Research) and 4 additional AP courses of their choice which will lead to the AP Capstone Diploma. To learn more, please attend this information session.
- AP Night, 5:30pm 6:30pm, Mall: This is a drop-in event whereby all AP classes will have a table set up in the Mall. Students / parents can meet with the AP teachers and learn more about each course to help them make informed decisions.
- 3) 10th grade Parent / student workshop, 6:30pm, Auditorium: This workshop will feature Rob Franek, Editor and Chief of The Princeton Review. (He loves Providence). He will discuss the college entrance exams (SAT vs. ACT) and the college planning process. Juniors and their parents are also invited to attend because it has been a few years since Rob was able to visit with Providence so they have not heard his message.

In other school news, we have a few parking spaces that have opened up in the Student Parking lot due to mid-year graduates moving on from Providence. Juniors and Seniors who qualify are to submit their paperwork to the main office by **Monday**, **January 30**, **2:30pm**. We will have a lottery process to sell these few parking spots. We have announced this to the students during this week and last week but I wanted to inform parents as well.

And finally, on Monday, students will receive their 1st semester Report Cards in homeroom. If a student failed a course due to attendance, the F will be reflected on the Report Card. In PowerSchool, the numeric grade may show a passing grade, but in compliance with CMS Policy, the grade has been changed to F which will show on the Report Card. Overall, our students have done a great job of taking care of their Attendance Recovery responsibilities. We need to keep that up during 2nd semester.

As always, thank you for sharing your children with us. It is our pleasure to get to work with them.
