A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

Dear PHS parents and families:

Tomorrow, **Saturday, March 18**, CMS will host the drill meet for all JROTC programs throughout the district. **THERE CAN BE NO VEHICLES parked on campus**. We will have to tow any vehicle left on campus. We have discussed this with the students several times this week but wanted to make our parents aware as well. Thank you!

We have had a fun Spirit Week this week at Providence. Organized by our Leadership class, we have had competitions to see how many cans students can donate to the Student Hunger Drive. We've had themed dress-up days, and we ended the week with a dodgeball tournament and "Pie a Panther" contest. Ultimately, it has all been to bring awareness and raise funds for the Second Harvest Food Bank. To give online toward the food bank and have your gift go toward Providence's overall donation, please visit this <u>link</u>.

Mid-Term exam week is next week. Students in 4x4 classes will have mid-term exams on March 21–24 during their regular class time. All other classes will continue to meet as usual. The last day of the third quarter is March 24. The fourth quarter begins on March 28. Also, during this coming week,

200 seniors are required to take the ACT WorkKeys test. This is an industry-ready exam (reading and math test) that gives the students a score of Platinum, Gold, Silver or Bronze. Students were notified today if they are required to take the test.

We are continuing the Course Request process for next year.

- 1) Each year, we have a few juniors or seniors who can skip chemistry (which is a pre-requisite) and go directly into AP Chemistry or AP Biology. Since chemistry is a pre-requisite course, we want to make sure students will be successful even if they skip the foundational skill building course. If students who have already passed biology want to skip chemistry and enroll in AP Chemistry or AP Biology for next year (2023-24), and they have strong math and science skills, they can submit their request at this <u>link</u>. They will have a records review and/or an interview with Dr. Krahn or Ms. Wise. The deadline to request and complete the link is Friday, March 24. Once a decision is made about permitting the student to skip chemistry, the student will be contacted by his or her counselor.
- 2) Rising sophomores take Civic Literacy, a graduation requirement, in 10th grade. AP Government and Politics will now count toward the Civic Literacy graduation requirement. Our counselors have already met with the rising 10th grade students. If a rising 10th grader wants to take AP Government and Politics instead of Honors Civic Literacy, please complete the request at this link. Please refer to the full course description in our PHS Course Offering Guide to ensure that your child has the time, commitment, and work ethic to manage this AP class prior to requesting AP Government instead of Honors Civic Literacy. Families should consider that the majority of students in AP Government will be upper classmen who have previously completed Honors Civics and will have a deeper background prior to enrolling in AP Government. Rising 10th graders should expect work outside of class to fill in some knowledge gaps because they have not previously taken Civic Literacy. **The deadline to request and complete the link is Friday, March 24.**

We are out of school on **Monday, March 27** for a teacher workday at the end of third quarter. On **Tuesday, March 28**, we will administer the Panorama Survey, which is administered twice a year to all CMS students. We are asking that all our students participate in the survey, as their feedback will provide invaluable insight into their experiences and how to improve and adapt our school to their needs. The survey content will ask students to self-reflect on their own social-emotional learning skills, such as self-management and self-efficacy. The survey takes approximately 20-30 minutes to complete. We thank you in advance for your support.
