## A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

Dear PHS parents and families:

Happy Friday. Today is the last day of regular AP exams. We have administered about 1700 exams to about 900 students in the last 2 weeks. Whew. I know our students are glad to have that behind them. I'm sure they have worked hard to put their best foot forward.

Tomorrow night is our **Prom**. Today, I reminded students that Prom is a school-sponsored event and all rules are in effect just as if we are at school or on a school field trip. We want our students to make smart decisions and be safe over the weekend.

Again, this week, I have reminded the students of their **Attendance Recovery** obligations. The last day to do Attendance Recovery is June 1. Please review your child's absences per course. If they have absences above 10 in any course, they automatically receive a failing grade (F) in the course unless they do Attendance Recovery to make up any time over 10 absences. Students can do Attendance Recovery every morning before school at 6:15am in room 403. They can also do Attendance Recovery every afternoon (except Fridays) in SMC (the Student Management Center) from 2:15 – 3:00pm. Lastly, any time they spend with their teacher in tutoring after school, making up a test or quiz after school, etc. can count towards Attendance Recovery. Ms. Reda, our Attendance Secretary, is the expert in Attendance Recovery so if you have any questions, please contact her in the main office.

Students who cannot fully complete all of their Attendance Recovery time, can do as much time as is available and submit an Attendance Recovery Appeal Form. Forms will be available at the end of May. In order for an appeal to be granted, students will need to have doctor's notes or other documentation to explain why they have a large number of absences and / or why they were unable to complete the Attendance Recovery.

Next week, we are hosting **Junior Week** to help our juniors get a head start on their college applications. There is so much they can do to get ahead over the summer months. It will make their life much easier than waiting until school starts in August. Please see the message below with all the details for them.

I have shared the <u>specific</u> **Final Exam** schedule with students. It is on the #OneProv Canvas page for all of them to access. If students have doctor appointments or other off-campus obligations during this time, we ask that you please reschedule them. Students will not be able to leave campus before 12:30pm each day during exams. If they are unable to reschedule an appointment, we will have a make-up exam day on June 9 and the student can take the exam then.

## New – Summer CDMs

The CDM window for summer 2023 is now open. Credit by Demonstrated Mastery (CDM) is an option that allows students to demonstrate mastery and receive credit for a course by taking an assessment demonstrating proficiency by achieving the designated scale score or percent as established by NCDPI and then completing an artifact reflecting content mastery. CDM is only available for standard-level courses. CDM credits are awarded as a pass/fail grade and therefore do not impact grade point averages.

Students who wish to participate in the CDM process during summer 2023 need to submit a completed application **no later than Friday**, **June 2 at 3 PM**. Phase I Assessments will be given from **July 18-31**. Phase II Assessments will be given **August 1-10**. The District Team will establish a testing plan and communicate all information to families. The team will also ensure that schools are notified of potential applicants for counseling sessions. Here is the <u>CDM One-Pager</u>, which includes process guidelines, FAQ, and the link to the application form.
