A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

Dear PHS parents and families,

Recently, the National Merit Scholarship Program notified us of the semifinalists for this year. The 2024 National Merit Scholarship program is based initially on student performance on the Preliminary SAT (PSAT) taken by all Juniors at Providence in 2022. The nationwide pool of semifinalists consists of less than one percent of all US high school seniors. As semifinalists, the students listed below will continue in the competition to earn a spot as a finalist. They will produce their academic record, participate in school and community activities, and demonstrate their leadership abilities, employment, and honors or awards received. Finalists will compete for a \$2500 college scholarship.

Congratulations to the following PHS Seniors who are National Merit Semifinalists: Savannah Bachmann, Anne Eilers, Maxwell Hu, Lydia Johnson, Sophia Kuncoro, Aiden Li, Nikhil Perego, Sara Schubert, Benjamin Uslan, and David Xie.

This week, we began Attendance Recovery. Students have been reminded that if they have more than 10 absences (excused or unexcused) in any course, they must complete Attendance Recovery in order to receive the academic grade they earned. If they do not complete their Attendance Recovery, the student will receive an F in the course. Attendance Recovery opportunities are available every morning from **6:15–7 AM** in room 402 (Mr. Rorie's classroom). Attendance Recovery opportunities are also available every afternoon (Monday–Thursday) in SMC with Ms. Fuller. Students can also earn Attendance Recovery credit by tutoring individually with their teacher. Each teacher has set tutoring opportunities. If a student wants to count the time in which they attended

tutoring toward their Attendance Recovery, they are to get an Attendance Recovery slip from Ms. Reda in the main office, ask their teacher with whom they attended tutoring to sign it, and then return the signed slip to Ms. Reda who will keep track of the Attendance Recovery time. **The last day to do Attendance Recovery for first semester will be January 17.**

Looking ahead to coming events, on **November 20** we will administer the Panorama Survey. Prior to this year, the survey was administered to all students twice a year. In August, parents were asked to complete a "Student Information Form" in alignment with SB49 – "Parents Bill of Rights." Only those students whose parents completed the form and opted for them to complete the survey will participate. The survey will ask students to self-reflect on their own social-emotional learning skills, like self-management and self-efficacy. The feedback will provide invaluable insights into their experiences and how to improve and adapt our school to their needs. The survey takes approximately 20-30 minutes to complete and will be administered in Homeroom. If you have any questions about the survey administration, please don't hesitate to contact Mr. McHugh (mark.mchugh@cms.k12.nc.us).

Player Registration

This year CMS has changed its process for athlete registration. The Dragonfly site will be used to collect all documents, including physicals, proof of residency, and other required documents. This site will also be where the required CMS athletic participation fee will be collected. All this information must be completed prior to first games, but many coaches may require this information to be completed shortly after tryouts. The registration site is dragonflyathletics.com. Please start this process now so there is no delay in students' participation in PHS sports.

Providence Athletic Fee

The Providence athletic fee, which is paid by student athletes, is the primary fundraiser for Providence Athletics and supports all PHS sports. Athletes are asked to contribute \$80 if they play one season and \$130 if they play two or three seasons, and all have the option to contribute more. The Providence athletic fee can be paid through https://www.pay4schoolstuff.com.
