A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

Dear Providence parents and families:

We have had a great first week of school. Students are doing an awesome job of getting back to work. We have worked on procedures, rules, and how we do things to make sure everyone in our large school can work smoothly and collaboratively together. We have had a grade level assembly for each grade level, our counselors have visited their students in homeroom, our assistant principals have visited their students in homeroom, homeroom teachers have reviewed the cell phone policy, dress code policy, Honor Code, and have read word for word the CMS Student Code of Conduct with their homeroom students. It is very important to us that students know and understand the expectations. We firmly believe that students will rise to the level of expectation we have if they are **taught** what the expectations are. We believe this because we have seen it happen year after year. **Students have responded very well**. Our staff members who are new to Providence have commented on how respectful our students are and how eager they are to learn. Many of them even thank their teacher at the end of class. You have done a good job sending them to us prepared. Now, we will do our job and get them ready to go out into the world prepared and ready!

As I met with each grade level in an opening assembly and reviewed the expectations, I gave students tips for success and some encouragement.

Those tips include:

- a. *Impress your teachers*. That doesn't mean you have to have the highest grade in the class, but you should always show good character, work hard, and try. Teachers can write a good recommendation for college or for a job when they see students consistently display good character.
- b. *Be nice. Be positive*. People would rather be around other people who are positive and have a "get it done" attitude.
- c. Utilize your <u>Sources of Strength</u>. In homeroom next week, our Sources of Strength Peer Leaders are training our 9th grade students on the SOS wheel and introducing them to the 8 Sources of Strength.
- d. Persevere and ask for help when you need it. In addition to all their teachers, students have access to their assigned counselor, their assigned administrator, an additional career counselor (Ms. Hall), Nurse Cunningham, and me. We made students aware of these resources and how to reach out to any of us when they need help. We are here to work together as a team for <u>their</u> success. After high school, students won't have all of us as their support, so we are working on teaching them how to utilize their Sources of Strength and persevere when they are confronted with challenges.

I wanted you to know what was shared so you can reinforce these tips at home. Maybe this would be good dinner conversation this weekend.

We are looking to add two or three parents to our School Improvement Team. This team meets about once a month and monitors the school improvement plan. As required by state law, the school improvement plan set goals and action steps for continuous school improvement. We have four great parents who are serving on the team currently. We'd love to add more. If you are interested in serving, please self-nominate by completing the information at this <u>link</u>. Nominations are due by 5 PM on Thursday, September 15. Then, our PTSO will facilitate an election for these open seats. I'm happy to answer any questions you might have.

Player Registration

This year CMS has changed its process for athlete registration. The Dragonfly site will be used to collect all documents, including physicals, proof of residency, and other required documents. This site will also be where the required CMS athletic participation fee will be collected. All this information must be completed prior to first games, but many coaches may require this information to be completed shortly after tryouts.
