# A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

Dear Providence parents and families:

Happy Fall. As summer gives way to fall, it is an especially busy time of year for our large, comprehensive high school. But, we love it! We love the excitement of teaching and learning and the many activities that permeate the school. This week, I have the following announcements and information to share so that we can all stay informed:

#### **ParentSquare**

Mid-Quarter Progress Reports in all PHS classes will be sent out via ParentSquare on **October 3**. If you have not been receiving messages via ParentSquare, please make sure you can receive them by **October 3** so you do not miss important information. (Today's edition of the <u>Mews</u> will go out via direct email and via ParentSquare). If you have questions about accessing ParentSquare, please contact Ms. Felder, our School Registrar, at <u>Christinac.Felder@cms.k12.nc.us</u>.

Please note: You will get a report from each class in which your child is enrolled. If you have your ParentSquare setting on "digest," they will come on one list, rather than 6 or 8 separate messages. We wanted you to be aware so that on **October 3**, you are not alarmed by the number of messages going out in a single day. As a parent, I think you will appreciate the ease of ParentSquare Progress Reports rather than separate emails, separate paper copies, separate Google forms to complete for each of your child's courses. We hope this helps you stay informed.

#### **Parent Workshops**

Each year, our School Counseling team offers a series of Parent Workshops to help parents learn information relevant to their child's progression through High School and preparation for life after High

School. Some Parent Workshops feature guest presenters. Some of them feature our very own, talented counselors. Listed below is the Parent Workshop schedule (except for 9<sup>th</sup> grade parent night which is still in the planning phase) for this school year so that you will know well in advance:

October 25, 6:30 PM	College Board Digital SAT workshop. Guest speaker from The College Board. The target audience is 10 <sup>th</sup> and 11 <sup>th</sup> graders and their parents. There are many changes to the SAT due to the digital format and we want to give our students the best information. Meet in the PHS Auditorium.		
November 15, 6:30 PM	Junior Night: Information for 11 <sup>th</sup> graders and their parents regarding ACT / SAT testing for college entrance, other items students need to work on during their Junior year to be prepared for summer and the college application process. Meet in the PHS Auditorium.		
November 28, 6:30 PM	Financial Aid Night. Meet in the Media Center. Our guest speaker is Tamika Rufkin from CFNC. She will discuss the FAFSA, Financial Aid, Scholarships, and how to pay for college.		

## Pre-ACT and PSAT testing

In mid-October, our 10<sup>th</sup> graders will take the Pre-ACT test. This test is paid for by CMS and is a practice to help show students what will be on the ACT which is one of the college admissions tests they will take as 11<sup>th</sup> graders. Testing will be during the regular school day on **October 18**. Parents will receive a report and be able to help identify any weak areas for their child that need to be worked on prior to next year. More details are forthcoming.

Also, in mid-October, our 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders will take the PSAT test. This test is also paid for by CMS and is a practice for the SAT which is the other admissions test colleges will accept. The PSAT will be given during the regular school day on **October 25**. Tenth and 11<sup>th</sup> graders will need their fully charged Chromebooks since the test is online. This will give them a taste of what the new online SAT looks like. Again, parents will receive a report and be able to help identify any weak areas that need to be improved upon.

#### **Mid-Term Exams for 4x4 Classes**

Mid-Term exams for 4x4 classes will be given during the regular school day on **October 31** and **November 1-3**. We will follow the normal bell schedule. Students will have only 1 4x4 mid-term per day so they can put their best foot forward. Other classes will meet and continue to carry on as usual. The last day of the quarter is **November 3**, which means we are at the half-way point in the course for all 4x4 classes.
